It must state dates of employment and termination. • A letter signed by the shipper that he will live in Slovenia, all the goods are in his 	<p>Tax free import is only possible within 12 months after arriving / returning to Slovenia (EU).</p> <p>All the goods intended for import must be declared to customs upon first import customs clearance.</p> <p>Goods must not be sold, hired, lent or otherwise disposed within 12 months after importation.</p>	<p>In case the letter from a third party confirming that shipper has lived outside EU is not available, other documents not specified but clearly proving living outside EU are acceptable.</p> <p>Sometimes Customs may require also other documents like Rental contract, copy of employment contract and others.</p> <p>If shipper cannot present complete import documents contact your FIDI agent for possibilities to release the goods from Customs.</p>
